

Note:

- If scanning of QR code is required and a patron's vaccination record or the medical exemption certificate does not contain a relevant QR code, then he/she must complete the specified form available on the COVID-19 Thematic Website (<https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/vaccine-pass.html>) or relevant website of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department to make a declaration upon entry into the premises and the person-in-charge must keep the records for 31 days.
- If a patron is a child aged below 12 not accompanied by an adult, he/she must complete the specified form available on the COVID-19 Thematic Website (<https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/vaccine-pass.html>) upon entry into the premises and the person-in-charge must keep the records for 31 days.
- Persons-in-charge of all specified premises listed above are also required, under the relevant directions issued under Cap. 599F, to ensure that patrons scan the LeaveHomeSafe QR code upon entry into the premises (except for outdoor sports premises where this is to be done as far as feasible).
